## How it Works:

The Landforce season has two parts: training and employment. Only those who successfully complete training can be considered for employment.

### **Training:**

- 7 weeks of paid training begins March 21st, 2022.  
(\$11.85/hour for 35 hours/week plus a bonus for completing training.)
  - Hard and soft skills training, certifications (including First Aid, Tree Tender, OSHA 40, Chainsaw Safety, and Restorative Practices), professional development, and work readiness training.
  - We intend to hold in-person training, but recognize that COVID-19 conditions may require a portion of training to be held virtually.

### **Employment:**

- Temporary land stewardship position following training and ending in Fall 2022.
- Work on projects like tree planting & care, rain garden & bioswale installation & maintenance, deconstruction, invasive plant removal, trail construction, and basic construction.
- One-on-one career coaching, further work readiness training, opportunities for additional professional certifications, and next step job searches that are meant to contribute towards future full-time employment.
- Up to \$16/hour for 36 hours/week.
